

Medical imaging plays a vital role in Australia's public and private health system.



Our members provide medical advice to patients and their referring doctors, using diagnostic facilities and imaging skills.



Medicare Benefits by Broad Type of Service, 2005/06







Big challenges New technology Scarce dollars

Everywhere, as new skills and equipment breakthroughs emerge, the cost of providing advanced facilities inevitably grows.


